

When evaluating the cost of a Franklin Academy's education, please note that unlike other schools, our tuition is an all-inclusive fee which includes room and board (for residential students), counseling, additional academic assistance, books, and laundry, as well as technology and facility fees. Not included in our cost is transportation from home to campus and back during vacations, weekly allowances, or special intersession travel.

To facilitate the family budget and cash flow, Franklin Academy offers a quarterly payment schedule. On a case-by-case basis, the Headmaster has discretionary authority to negotiate an alternative monthly payment schedule. For those families able to make one lump sum payment of the entire tuition for a school year, Franklin Academy offers a popular pre-pay discount of \$5,000.

While Franklin Academy does not offer financial assistance, many of our families (approximately 35%) receive significant financial support from their local school district, typically in the form of reimbursements for tuition paid to Franklin Academy. In addition, some parents follow the instructions found in Publication 502 of the Internal Revenue Service to claim the cost of attending Franklin Academy as a medical expense. Please note that we recommend the counsel of a lawyer or tax advisor if you decide to pursue either of these options.
