







Coming to Franklin Academy this Fall

Before you come:

<p>Quarantine</p> 	<p>Families are asked to voluntarily quarantine for 14 days prior to traveling to Franklin Academy</p>
<p>Testing</p> 	<p>Both parents and students should be tested and bring NEGATIVE COVID-19 results with them on their Opening Day. Optimally, tests will be no more than 72 hours old. Those traveling from states under restricted travel to CT must also complete a form issued by the State of CT (https://appengine.egov.com/apps/ct/DPH/Connecticut-Travel-Health-Form)</p>
<p>Pack lightly</p> 	<p>Parents will not be permitted in the dorm on Opening Day and we ask that students pack what they can carry to their floor with minimal assistance</p>
<p>Medical Forms</p> 	<p>All needed Health and Medical forms must be on file in our electronic health system in order for your student to remain on campus</p>

When you arrive:

<p>Drop off will be short and bittersweet!</p> 	<p>Parents will not be permitted in the dorm, but will be asked to check into the Health Center, meet our nursing staff and drop off any student medication</p>
<p>Mask and social distance</p> 	<p>Mask wearing is mandatory while on campus. Parents and students may take a “mask break” on the large field in front of the dining hall if needed, while distancing from others</p>
